

60 SECONDS IN THE SCRIPTURES

SALVATION IN ONE BODY

THE FACTS:

- ✓ God has established only one way for everyone to be saved (Jer. 32:9; Isa. 35:8; John 10:9; 14:6; Mark 16:15,16)
- ✓ There is only one Gospel plan of salvation that allows you to be a part of the one church (Acts 2:38-47)
- ✓ When people obeyed the Gospel in the New Testament they were simply called, “Christians” (Acts 11:26) and each individual was a part of the one body (the Lord’s church) (1 Cor. 12:20)
- ✓ The one body and the one church are exactly the same (Col. 1:24; Eph. 1:22,23)
- ✓ The one body is the church of Christ (Eph. 4:4; 1 Cor. 12:25; Col. 3:15; Eph. 2:16; 1 Cor. 12:13; Acts 2:47)
- ✓ Jesus said He would build His church (Mat. 16:18)—the church of Christ belongs to Him and he is the Savior of that one church (body) (Eph. 5:23)

THE FOCUS:

- ✓ We must be a member of the Lord’s body (church) in order to be saved (1 Cor. 12:13; Gal. 3:27; Eph. 5:23)
- ✓ God gives everyone the opportunity to be a part of His church (Titus 2:14)
- ✓ We must obey the Lord now while we have time and opportunity (2 Cor. 6:2; Heb. 5:8,9)
- ✓ No pleading with the Lord on judgment day will change our eternal destiny if we have not obeyed Him in our lifetime (Mat. 7:21-23)
- ✓ Don’t be misled by following the wrong doctrine or being in the wrong church (1 Cor. 1:10-17)
